### Mission Statement:

The club shall collectively work with the school district to promote projects that improve facilities and equipment necessary to provide an adequate interscholastic athletic program for the school district. To accomplish this purpose, the members shall support, sponsor and promote such fund raising activities as may be sanctioned by the membership.

Once again, the successful athletic program in the Olmsted Falls School System has 65 teams representing Olmsted Falls in 22 interscholastic sports. Each year the Athletic Booster Club calls upon the residents of the community to help defray the costs of operating our sports program.

Over the last few years, the Athletic Booster Club provided substantial funds necessary to assist in financing our interscholastic athletic program. Our contribution to the athletic department is used for the following items: new equipment, medical supplies, awards, tournament expenses, entry fees, uniforms and scholarships. The Athletic Booster Club has also been involved in major projects such as the **weight room/training room renovation**, tennis and track facilities, baseball/softball diamonds, soccer facility, outbuilding for sport storage, the renovation of the inside and outside concession areas, and the football stadium renovation. Olmsted Falls is the only school district in the Southwest Conference that does NOT pay to play or pay a transportation fee.

The Athletic Booster Club is budgeted to contribute at least \$65,000 for the 2018- 2019 school year. By becoming a patron, you can help us maintain and improve our excellent athletic program.
